## Scottish Government 'Phase 2' Easing of Lockdown

As announced 18/6 and revised 24/6:

22nd June: Places of worship can open for individual prayer with distancing and hygiene safeguards. 29th June: Weddings can take place outdoors with minimal attendance.

10th July (Indicative): Three households can meet together indoors with distancing.

## For Scottish Episcopal Churches this means:

22/6: Churches could (but do not HAVE TO) open for individual prayer if staffed, cleaned and managed.



29/6: People from more than one household can meet in church to rehearse, record worship etc.

29/6: Outdoor weddings with minimal attendance MAY be possible.

10/7: Indoor oneon-one pastoral visits may be possible by clergy / experienced visitors.

All proposals to re-open church buildings are a clergy/vestry decision. The church's plans MUST be approved by the bishop.
